## Sangeorgiu de Padure

We will be getting fuller details during our visit later this month, but in the meantime we know that the church building project at Sangeorgiu de Padure has come on very well, and the new building has been used for the first time. Pastor Janos Totos wrote to us last month -

*"We had a blessed Sunday on 26 August in Our new Church. We was able to keep the first Sermon in the new Church and the first baptism. The speaker was Daniel Webber, the EMF leader, translated by Pastor Istvan Borzasi. The Bible text was Acts 8.25-40*

*It was present Dóczi György, Sallai Jakab, Mate Miklos Pastors and about 200-250 people. The pastors helped with testimonies and prayers for the blessing, and serve the Lord Supper."*



## Better Home Project

Work is under way on 7 homes, but we have a long way to go....

These simple homes, with proper foundations, floor and roof are costing between £5,000 and £6,000 each, depending on the help with materials given by the local authority. [As part of the process, we are also providing some employment for men in the community.] If there is a man in the household he has to do the unskilled work for his home.



In order to get roofs on before winter we have sent to Romania every penny in our Better Home account. £20,000 has been sent to date, so **we are in urgent need of donations, however large or small.**



We now have confidence that the Romanian end of the project is going well, so need to keep supplying them. **Please help if you can.** There's a PayPal button at [betterhome.org.uk](http://betterhome.org.uk); or send cheques to this address, or BACS transfers please to 12-20-29 A/c 00291458 (please let us know if you have used BACS so we apply the funds to the right account). Gift Aid adds 28%, so let us know if you need a declaration form.
